### Winter Fun

#### Cross-country Skiing

The Indian Lake Pathways Ski Trail would be an excellent place to start. Just out of town on the west side of Indian Lake, the Indian Lake Pathways Ski Trail offer trails ranging from just under a mile in length to twenty three miles.

#### Snowshoeing

There is no better spot for that than the Rainey Memorial Wildlife Area. Located on the northeast end of Indian Lake, the Rainey Wildlife Area is a cooperative project between the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and the Michigan Conservation Foundation. At the end of the trail is a large open marshy area that is home to several species of wildlife.

#### Kitchi-ti-kiipi, or the Big Springs

Accessible in winter only by skis, snowshoes and snowmobile, the Big Springs are as lovely to see framed in white as it is in the other seasons.

#### Snowmobiling

There are hundreds of miles of groomed trails leading off in every direction regardless of where you start. One interesting place in particular is the "Thunder Bowl." An old abandoned ski hill, the Thunder Bowl is now the playground of snowmobiles and sleds alike.

#### Ice Fishing


Frozen lakes, rivers and bays teeming with fish just waiting for you to chop a hole and set your
