What's unique in Manistique?

The historic Siphon Bridge, constructed in 1919 and featured in 'Ripley's Believe it or Not,' is supported by water which is atmospherically forced under it.

The Schoolcraft County Historical Park is located in Manistique's central district. Among the park's attractions is Manistique's Water Tower, a Roman period architectural landmark with a 200,000 gallon capacity.

Benny the bearded fisher is a remarkable creation by Thomas Dambo, a renowned "Recycle Art Activist" from Denmark.

Manistique Social District is where you can stroll through the downtown area while waiting for a table or enjoy your eats at one of our outdoor dining areas. This program allows locals and visitors to purchase alcoholic beverages from participating bars and restaurants and then enjoy them throughout the district's common areas.

The Haywire Grade Trail, a multiuse year-round trail that stretches 32 miles and crosses the Upper Peninsula, south to north, from Intake Park in Manistique to Shingleton in Schoolcraft and Alger counties. The trail runs along the old Manistique and Lake Superior Railroad.

Michigan's largest fresh water spring - Kitch-iti-kipi.

Arts and entertainment at the Erickson Center for the Arts, The Pine Performance Center, Lake Effect Community Art Center, and a drive-in theater.

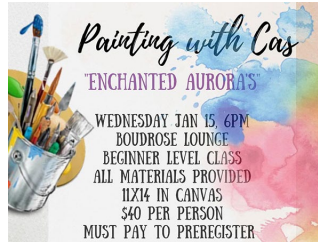
